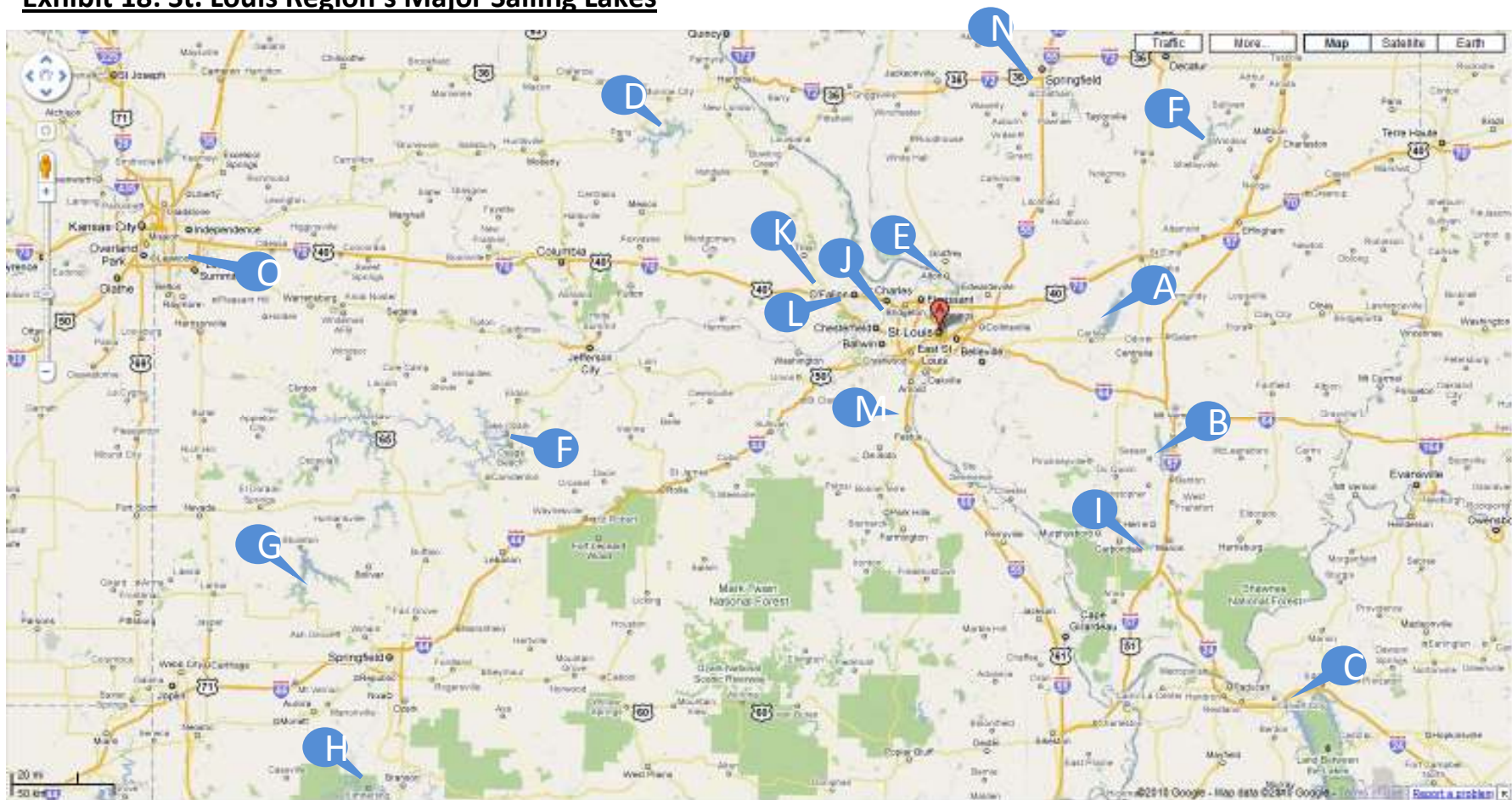


Exhibit 18: St. Louis Region's Major Sailing Lakes



- A. Carlyle Lake – 1 hour from St. Louis. 26,000 acres of water & 11,000 acres of land for camping/hunting. Voted best in-land US sailing lake. 4th marina recently added. Active sailing & regatta. Fishing popular in shallow north end.
- B. Rend Lake – 1.5 hours from St. Louis. 18,000 acre of water. Voted 7th wonder of Il. Fishing, kayaking, camping abound in this shallow lake. Marina & resort.
- C. Kentucky Lake – 3 hours from St. Louis. 160,300 acres with multiple marinas, resorts and campsites. Excellent sailing, kayaking and fishing.
- D. Mark Twain Lake – 2 hours from St. Louis. 18,600 acres. Excellent sailing, kayaking and fishing. Campsites and hunting. Marina.
- E. Alton Pool – 1 hour from St. Louis. Infinite Agerage! Several Marinas

- F. Lake of the Ozarks – 3 hour from St. Louis. 55,000 acres. Multiple marinas, resorts and attractions.1150 miles of shoreline packed with condos/homes.
- G. Stockton Lake – 4 hours from St. Louis. 25,000 acres of super clear water. One of the best sailing lakes for the Kansas City crowd.
- H. Table Rock Lake – 4 hours from St. Louis. . 43,100 acres of clear water with multiple marinas, resorts and campsites. Next to Branson’s attractions.
- I. Crab Orchard Lake – 2 hours from St. Louis. 7,000 acres. Kayaking and fishing.
